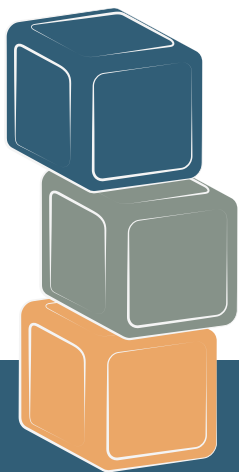
The first few years of life are a period of exponential brain growth and development but there is still so much we do not know about the effects of early exposures on infant and child development.
