## Who can participate?



Infants and toddlers  
between 4-24 months of age

## What's involved?

The study involves two main activities:



**#1:** Your child's heart rate will be monitored while we play some sounds and show some pictures and smells. The heart rate sensor will gently be placed on your child's skin over the heart; it cannot harm your child.



**#2:** Your child will participate in developmental testing which includes some fun activities to see how his/her development is coming along in a few different areas, such as language, motor skills, and attention.
