

Perinatal epidemiology postdoctoral fellowship opportunity

The Division of Environmental Science and Health in the Department of Pediatrics in the School of Medicine at the University of California San Diego is seeking a researcher interested in a postdoctoral fellowship in perinatal pharmacoepidemiology. This is a 2-year fellowship with the possibility for renewal for an additional year. The postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to work with a multidisciplinary team of researchers on two primary projects: an R01 grant investigating adverse birth outcomes among pregnant individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities, and a U01 grant investigating a wide variety of pregnancy and early life exposures and childhood development. This position will provide an opportunity to conduct analyses with multiple data sources, including prospective birth cohorts, administrative claims databases and electronic health records. The successful candidate will have an interest in perinatal epidemiology or pharmacoepidemiology.

Successful candidate must have:

- PhD in epidemiology, pharmacoepidemiology, pharmacy, biostatistics, outcomes research, or related fields.
- Strong programming skills in R, SAS, or SQL.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills and track record of peer-reviewed publications.

Although on-site work at UCSD is preferred, consideration will be made for remote-based candidates.
